Baby of Syed Imran (Syed Idris) 3M/M

Syed Imran was working as a salesman at a cloth merchant in Hyderabad when his three-month-old son developed shortness of breath, a severe cold, and an inability to take his feeds. A pediatrician advised him to see a cardiologist for a thorough examination. His doctor recommended that he go to STAR Hospital. Dr. Suman Vyas, a cardiologist at STAR Hospital, examined the child, and a 2D echo revealed that he had a major congenital cardiac abnormality known as an AP Window (a heart defect in which there is a hole between the blood vessel that feeds the heart (the aorta) and the blood vessel that goes to the lungs (the pulmonary artery), which required surgery to save his life.

The treatment cost INR 5,00,000, which the parents, Syed Imran and Sameena, could not afford. Parents requested that Dr. Suman Vyas guide them with their child's treatment. The doctor referred the case to the Hrudaya Foundation and asked the parents to seek assistance with the costs of treatment. The baby underwent lifesaving surgery on April 23, 2024, at STAR Hospital and is currently doing well.
