Shiva's journey began with a challenging diagnosis of a severe heart condition soon after his birth. His father, Prashanth, a diligent daily wage earner, and his mother, Sravani, were residents of the Medak district. Despite their limited means, they were determined to find the best possible care for their newborn son.
